## Operations Summary, Construction and Related Issues

- The installation of a gate at the flood wall for controlling storm water and wastewater in the 54" line from Binghamton has been completed. Testing protocol was planned for this week, but needed to be delayed due to high flows.
- A significant amount of training continues to take place. Our staff (Head Electrician) has worked to get a number of the training modules approved for operator recertification credit hours.
- The covers for the digesters are projected to be installed in the next several weeks, and the solids handling contract is expected to require sludge to the digesters in mid to late March. Logistics regarding the loadings required to maintain digester operation are being reviewed by GHD because we do not believe we will have sufficient quantities to keep all 3 digesters in operation.

### **Other**

- The Water Quality Improvement Contract has been awarded and the kick off meeting was held January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- The monthly meeting with the DEC was held on February 11th, 2019. An update on the construction progress was given and deadlines for meeting permit requirements was discussed. The repair of imperfections to CN cell 2 wall, and the concrete utility corridor issues appear to be resolved, and the Kruger media is scheduled to be installed beginning March 25th. The Storm Water Protection Notice of Violation was also discussed and a tentative meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, March 5th at 9:30 am.
